RULES

1. The Senior and Junior Shows are Sanctioned by the ADGA for the following Breeds: Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, Sable, Toggenburg, and Recorded Grade. This is the order of the show.
2. ADGA rules shall govern these shows. "The order of the shows are subject to change."
3. Entry fee is \$5.00 per animal. Fees must accompany the entry form to the Show Chairman. Checks should be made payable to "Best in the Northwest 4-H Club".
4. The base day of the show is Aug 24, 2019.
5. The starting time for the show is 10:00 am (Ohio time).
6. The **Original Registration Certificate or stamped Duplicate form** from the ADGA office is required for all animals under 6 months of age and must be shown to the Show Chair or Secretary before the start of the show.
7. The Original **Registration Certificate** is required for all animals age 6 months or older and must be shown to the Show Chair or Secretary before the start of the show. No copies, photos, fax, email or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the original Registration Certificate or Stamped Duplicate. Must be "on paper" to be accepted.
8. Proper Health papers are required in the state of Ohio for all animals from other states, and must comply with Ohio Regulations. Papers and animals will be checked before animals are unloaded from the trailers. Animals showing any signs of infectious disease or ill health will be banned from showing. Certificate of Veterinary Inspection must be dated **within 30 days** of the show. The Owner and the Veterinarian must attest to the following: "**The Goats in this shipment are not known to be under any movement restrictions because of Scrapies and originate from a Tuberculosis Free Herd.**" No telephone calls will be accepted in lieu of the correct Certificate of Veterinary Inspection papers. **Any questions can be answered by calling the Ohio Department of Agriculture at (614) 728-6220.**
9. All animals must be from herds that are registered in the National Scrapies Database. They must be properly tattooed or tagged with proper identification. For more information on the National Scrapies Database call the U. S. Department of Agriculture at (614) 469-5602.
10. **Horned animals are NOT allowed. NO EXCEPTIONS. No DOGS are allowed in the barns, show area or fairgrounds.**
11. Any person not acting in an honorable manner will be asked to leave the fairgrounds immediately and not return for the remainder of the show.
12. **The Best in the Northwest 4-H Club, the Defiance County Agriculture Society members, the Defiance County Fairgrounds and Fair Board, it's members and associates will NOT be responsible for the loss, damage, theft, injury, or illness to animal(s), equipment, or persons attending.**
13. A Veterinarian will be on call to settle any disputes on banned animals. The exhibitor will pay for the expenses of the Veterinarian. **The Veterinarian decision will be final.**
14. There will be a payback of \$5 for first place and \$3 for second place in all the classes.
15. Showing of animals in the Champion Challenge Class: Proof of Championship can be either the Prefix CH, GCH, or SGCH as affixed by the ADGA on the animal's Registration/Recordation Certificate, or presentation of the Notification Letter issued by ADGA in conjunction with the original Registration Certificate. The letter is valid for use until December 31st of the year of issuance, after which the Certificate must be officially updated, if using for show purposes.
16. **No entry before 6am on Saturday Aug. 24, 2019.**
