



Sheep Lead Contest
Saturday, August 17, 2019
4:00 pm – Livestock Show Arena

The objectives of the lead contest are to present a class of sheep in the most attractive manner, to give spectators an opportunity to view a wool style show and to promote lamb and wool. This contest is open to all guys and gals who have an interest in sheep or wool fashion. Contestants will model a wool outfit while leading a sheep at halter. The entrant does not have to own the sheep that is being shown.

1. Entry Fee: \$5 with a registration form. Entry forms are available through the Extension Office and at the Junior Fair Office during the fair. Must submit a written description of the garment the entrant will wear with the registration form.
2. The sheep should be presented as a show animal. It may be any breed ewe lamb or yearling ewe, and it must be halter broken.
3. All participants will be asked to lead a sheep once around the show arena prior to walking on the runway.
4. No ram lambs will be allowed.
5. Ownership of animal is not required.
6. The entrant's entire outfit or any major part of their outfit, such as a jumper, dress, coat, jacket, vest, or slacks, must include at least 70% wool.
7. The outfit may be either handmade or purchased.
8. No outfits worn more than one year at Defiance County.
9. Class ages are determined by the age of the entrant as of the contest date for all classes.
10. Check-in is at 15 minutes prior to start of competition.
11. Awards will be presented to the first place in each class.

Classes:

Adult	(ages 16 & older)
Intermediate	(ages 9-15)
Pee Wee	(ages 3-8)

Overall Champion Selected
 The winner from each age division will come back
 for the Overall Champion Award.

Judging Standards:

Entrant's poise and appearance
 Garment appearance and originality
 Control and presentation of animal
