

Livestock Guideline Changes ~ 2024

Skillathon:

- 2024 Stations will be parts and meat cuts
- 2024 Skillathon Time: 5:00 7:00 pm
- 2024: Supplemental Pages will replace record book requirements

Steer/Market Heifer Tagging REQUIRED:

 Tagging for all market steers & market heifers for Defiance County Fair is in person on Saturday, January 13, 2023 from 9:00 am – 11:00 AM at the Fairgrounds. This is regardless if animal already has a tag. This is to verify possession. Animal will also be weighed for rate of gain.

Central Tagging:

- NEW TIME: Central Tagging will be June 8th from 7:00 am 10:00 am.
- NEW: Families with market animals not present at Central Tagging will be charged a \$50 farm visit and \$10/tag which is payable up front.

Horses:

- Pleasure Classes are limited to one exhibitor per class. Example- can't take two horses in western showmanship (does not apply to contesting).
- Split show. Contesting/Tues., at 9:00 am. Pleasure/Wed., at 9:00 am
- Removed Class Limits
- Alumni showmanship class will be added to the Thursday Fun Show. \$5/person entry fee, winner takes half.

Cattle:

- Bring back Rate of Gain
- Add Defiance County Born & Raised Class
- NEW: All steers and market heifers must come to tagging at fairgrounds on Jan 13[,] 2024. This is for ALL potential entries for county and state fair to verify possession. Exhibitors wanted to participate in rate of gain may have animal weighed.

Dairy:

 Alumni showmanship class will be added to Wednesday Dairy Show. \$5/person entry fee, winner takes half.

Dogs:

Alumni showmanship class will be added. \$5/person entry fee, winner takes half.

Goats:

- Pygmy classes will be in the tent
- Alumni showmanship class will be added. \$5/person entry fee, winner takes half.

Swine:

• Market weight classes have been pre-determined for 2024.

- 180 lbs - 239 lbs Lightweight
- 240 lbs - 269 lbs Middleweight
- 270 lbs - & up Heavyweight

Poultry

- Market Duck: Eliminated pen of 2, single entry either sex.
- Market Duck: Recommended age 15-20 weeks, Jumbo is allowed. Weight 5-12 lbs
- Market Turkey: Minimum weight of 20 lbs
- Market Chickens: Bring back bulk order
- Market Chickens: Max weight of 15 lbs for broiler pen
- Poultry Class Entries: Limited to two entries per class with NO TOTAL CLASS LIMITS.
