Guidelines:

Defiance County 4-H Council is looking to promote 4-H during March enrollment period and during National 4-H Week (Oct. 2-8, 2016). Clubs may decorate a window or store front. Your club can plan and build a window display that lets people know what 4-H has to offer. Each club that constructs an educational and promotional window display is eligible to receive a \$20 display fee to help cover the costs.

1. The display can be constructed in any large storefront window in your community.
2. This concept is very similar to a 4-H Booth Display.
3. Be original in designing and constructing your display.
4. You can use educational posters, members' projects, etc.
5. Must include contact information for your club and the Extension Office.
6. Must contact business and receive permission.
7. Clubs will receive Honor Club points.
8. Send a photo of your display to the Extension Office to johnson.1389@osu.edu
